Carolyn is one of five Californians this year to receive the Award, which was presented to her on Monday by California State Superintendent Tom Torlakson. The Awards, which aim to spotlight model solutions that could better the lives of more Californians if replicated by policymakers and others, include \$125,000 in support for each recipient's organization.
