## **17 Students Honored for Service to the LGBTQ Community**

San Francisco, May 21, 2012 ? eQuality Scholarship Collaborative has announced the recipients of its 2012 scholarships, presented at the 23rd Annual Awards Dinner held Friday at the Hotel Nikko in San Francisco.

Seventeen young leaders from throughout the State were honored and recognized for their service to the LGBTQ community. Fifteen graduating high school seniors received \$5,000 scholarships toward their post-secondary education. A nursing and a medical scholarship also were awarded.

Five additional students from the communities of Fair Oaks, Mill Valley, Oakdale, San Francisco, and San Ramon also received awards.

The scholarships will be applied at institutions from the City College of San Francisco to Harvard University and in studies ranging from cosmetology to international relations.

Over the past 23 years, the Collaborative has provided more than a half million dollars in financial

assistance to well over 200 graduating high school seniors, as well as nursing and medical students. It is California's premier LGBTQ and ally youth service-recognition program.
