Because if Governor Brown signs the School Success and Opportunity Act into law, it will mean I can finally go to school and succeed as myself. I'll be able to fully participate in all of my classes, try out for sports teams, and stay on track to graduate.

Thank you to everyone who [signed my petition](#) ^[2], to the other GSA youth leaders who advocated for this bill, and to the incredible community supporting transgender students across the state. This was a huge day for me and, thanks to all of you, it should be a memorable one for the Governor, too.
