Tone Indicators

What are Tone Indicators? Tone indicators are used to indicate if the person is joking, being serious etc. etc. Neurodivergent people have trouble conveying or understanding emotion and tone through written text, using tone indicators is really helpful for neurodivergent people to make it easier for them to read/convey, it is also very helpful for people with anxiety.

Why should we use them? People don't always pick up the tone of the message but when we use tone indicators, it helps people, especially neurodivergent people understand the intention and tone of someone's message. Tone tags can be really helpful.

What is Neurodiversity? Refers to the range of differences in individual brain function and behavioral traits. Neurodivergent people can include but not limited to folks who are autistic, ADHD, dyslexic, etc.


- What is GSA Day 4 Racial Justice?
 - National GSA Day 4 Racial Justice is an annual day of action to mobilize for racial justice and celebrate the multiple identities we hold as LGBTQ youth.

Theme

- We call for Decolonization and Reparations for all Indigenous and Black Peoples
 - We call for the payment of reparations that are owed and the reclamation of cultural practices by the communities from which they originated. We call for the active and complacent perpetrators of cultural appropriation and colonization to be held accountable and to recognize the privilege they maintain through the oppression of others. (TRUTH 2018)





Definitions

Decolonization: The "cultural, psychological, and economic freedom" for Indigenous people with the goal of achieving Indigenous sovereignty — the right and ability of Indigenous people to practice self-determination over their land, cultures, and political and economic systems.

Reparations: The act of or process of making amends for a wrong. (M4BL, Reparations)

Land Back: A movement that seeks to re-establish Indigenous folks' political and economic control over land that has historically belonged to them prior to colonization. Settler Colonialism: A form of colonialism that seeks to replace Indigenous folks through the removal and erasure of culture and land.

TQ2S+: trans, queer, Two-Spirit +

Two-Spirit/2S: Indigenous people who have both feminine and masculine spirits. Depending on the tribe, a person's Two-Spirit identity can describe how they express themself, what work they do in the community, and/or what role they may have in traditional ceremonies.
